

St Catherines reef, Loch Fyne (Main Reef and Rody reef)

The most popular site on Loch Fyne! It's popularity is justified with two interesting reefs to pick from and ample car parking. A gradual slope to depth and rocky sea scope offer lots to explore for both trainees and experienced divers alike. Both reefs have resident congers and are teeming with life. The main reef is sometimes visited by large shoals and rare species like John Dories have been photographed here. The second reef, known as Rody reef by MUSAC Divers (due to the rhododendron bush at the entry path) is particularly good for conger eels, dogfish and macro life.
